

# Scotts Road Forestry & Log Transport

## Summary of Feedback from 2012-13 harvest season

### End of season feedback

In June this year feedback was sought from Scotts Road residents on the transport operations over the previous summer harvest period. A feedback form was delivered and mailed out to residents on the road. A total of four responses were received. A summary of the main points raised and responses to these points are set out below.

#### Operation went well (4 responses)

- Logging truck drivers courteous.
- Trucks slow down or stop for stock on road
- No problems
- No complaints

#### Poor quality of unsealed section of road (1 responses)

- Grading of road is substandard during and after the trucks use it.
- Condition of road is as bad as it was 22 years ago

#### *Response:*

Maintenance of the unsealed section of the road is undertaken by Palmerston North City Council roading contractors and will continue to be maintained as a basic unsealed rural road.

Concerns have been passed onto the roading maintenance managers. Specific road maintenance concerns can be lodged directly through the main Palmerston North City Council phone number 356 8199.

### End of season meeting

None of the four respondents saw the need for a feedback meeting. No meeting was held
