Scotts Road Forestry – Season Feedback

Following on from our update note of 26 June..

Feedback

We have had no feedback in response to our contact of 26 June.

There was a small amount of feedback received during the season as follows:

Engine brakes early in the morning: In response to this feedback transport contractors were re-contacted to reinforce the requirement not to use engine breaks early in the morning. We are also now looking at other ways to reinforce this with drivers, including possibly signage for drivers further up the road.

Speed: We received one comment about truck speed through the built up area. Again this has been followed up and the requirement for reduced speed through this area reinforced to drivers. Our understanding is that lower speeds have generally been well observed.

Feedback meeting postponed.

As there has been no feedback in relation to the latest mail drop, there does not seem to be sufficient interest to warrant holding a public feedback meeting. So we have decided at this stage to postpone the meeting planned for 22 July.
